-Contested Lok Sabha Elections 1999 against Vasundhra Raje Scindia and secured 2, 57,159 votes.

-In 2002 Smt. Sonia Gandhi was kind enough to give him a Rajya Sabha nomination.

-In 2004 appointed as Working President of Rajasthan PCC.

-On 4.5.2004 died in a car accident at 0330 hours during his tireless day and

night campaign in the 2004 Lok Sabha elections.

He was a highly respectable, talented and extremely popular leader of Rajasthan.

I belong to political family since childhood; my father was a well known freedom fighter from Rajasthan.

My association with the Congress Party and Gandhi family became more integrated after the visit of Late Mrs. Indira Gandhiji to our residence at Jhalawar in Rajasthan and this has also encouraged me to take active part in the politics under the guidance of various distinguished leaders of Congress from time to time from the last 15 years.
