TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF VEHICLE OF NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR WOMEN(NCW)

The terms and conditions for the disposal of the vehicles are as follows:

- 1. An EMD of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) (Rs.10,000/- for each vehicle) for three vehicles in the form of Demand Draft in favour of PAO, National Commission for Women, payable at New Delhi should accompany the bid. The bids without EMD will be summarily rejected.
